WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

❖ ***Directs, manages and evaluates student learning in the clinical setting.***

- Orientation of stations
- Evaluation of working hours
- Orientation of supportive supervision staff
- Working non-human resources

WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

❖ ***Prepares clinical staff's assistants and preceptors for their teaching activities and approaches specific to the level of the learner and course's outcomes.***

- Orientation of agreed supervision tools including
 - ✓ Assessment plan,
 - ✓ Checklist etc.
- Induction courses of basics of curriculum
- Orientation of agreed clinical master plan



WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

- ❖ ***Assists the student in integration of theory and practice, specific to the course's learning activities and level of the learner.***
- Bed to bed presentation and discussion
- Departmental students competency assessment
- ❖ ***Evaluates the student's development of clinical reasoning skills.***
- Pre clinical assessment
- Post clinical assessment



WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

❖ ***Facilitates clinical seminars (in absence of the clinical faculty coordinator).***

- Any clinical management updates
- Building capacity
- Clearing management misconceptions

❖ ***Is available at all times the student is in the clinical setting.***

- Seniority clinical support to students

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WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

❖ ***Directly observes and guides students' learning activities with clients***

- Students objectives
- Institution objectives
- Profession objectives
- Client's demands and perceptions

❖ ***Evaluates students in clinical as related to the Program outcomes.***

- Curriculum base requirements
- Health bodies requirements



WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

- ❖ ***Participates as a member of the course team in the course's development and evaluation activities with the lead faculty.***
 - Sharing of arising challenges
 - Pre and post assessment demands
- ❖ ***Provides timely and ongoing feedback to the lead faculty regarding individual student and group performance in accomplishment of the course's outcomes***
 - Strengths
 - Weaknesses
 - Area for improvements



WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

- ❖ ***Evaluates clinical staff assistants and preceptors for their teaching effectiveness and provides feedback to the lead faculty.***
 - Overall clinical presentation
 - Proper utilization of supervision tools
 - ***Provides feedback to the lead faculty (or to clinical faculty coordinator with) regarding the clinical setting's effectiveness in supporting student accomplishment of the course and program outcomes.***
 - Performance
 - Rotation time
 - Supervision tools



WHAT CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR DO?

❖ ***Is a resource for nurses for educational opportunities for their professional development.***

- Presentations
- Update sharing

❖ ***Serves as a liaison between the clinical agency and school of nursing***

- Institution tools
- Solving problems
- Feedback sharing
- Educational conference organizing
